The Children's Ministry at Great Hills is committed to partnering with parents to help children discover a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. We strive to accomplish this through relevant teaching that will engage children with the truths of the Bible.

AWANA

The Goal of AWANA is to reach boys and girls with the Gospel of Christ and train them to serve Him.



The AWANA Emphasis:

Bible knowledge personally applied: While AWANA has many activities to interest boys and girls, such as games and special activities, the heart of the program is Bible memory work. Believing that God means what He said when He promised to bless His Word, AWANA encourages the clubbers to hide His Word in their hearts. The clubber handbooks contain between 30 and 90 verses depending on the age group, with material becoming increasingly harder as they get older. But not to worry, clubbers will find that they become more comfortable with the memorization process as they move from club to club
AWANA meets Sunday evenings at 6:05, September through May.



KidStuf happens every week at GHBC for 1-5 graders. It is a unique approach to engage children and families in learning the core truths of the Bible.

KidStuf has three rotations:

- **PLUG-IN:** Plug In is designed to introduce children to the day's topic in a setting that gives them individualized attention from their Small Group Leader and plenty of interaction with a small group of peers.
- **POWER-UP:** Power Up is designed to engage children in worship in a large group setting. Music, prayer, and an innovative approach to the Bible story are always a part of this interactive time.
- **CATCH-ON:** Catch On is designed to help kids understand how the day's topic applies to them. They'll discuss real-life experiences, interact with a close-knit group of peers, and participate in a variety of activities that appeal to different learning styles.

KidStuf is built around three Basic Truths every child should embrace according to what Jesus modeled in Luke 2:52. "...and Jesus grew in wisdom and stature and favor with God and man." Out of this verse there are three core values that are revealed:

- I can make the wise choice (wisdom)
- I can trust God no matter what (faith)
- I should treat others the way that I want to be treated (relationships)
